The PCC met this week and after welcoming Milota as secretary, sharing encouragements and a look at Philippians 2, we then

- agreed to instruct the architect to draw up new drawings for the St Andrews church redevelopment. After much thought and prayers, the PCC have agreed a simpler scheme which will cost less (the new drawings should be available in three weeks)
- asked Anthony and the wardens to find a solicitor for the building of the houses
- discussed the workload on Anthony as vicar and on our volunteers and recognised the need to keep this under review
- heard the good news that the 2019 accounts look like being in surplus and began the process of budgeting for 2020
- accepted a substantial gift which will be given to enable us to look at employing a theologically educated person on a two-year contract. The PCC committed to use some of the savings to fund the project and hoped the person might start in September 2020
- heard about existing developments in homegroup, Bay Ignite, Christianity Explained and Sunday Services
- heard that we will be doing some work on the North and South Rooms exteriors
- talked about the local CAP and Street Pastors and agreed to investigate more details.
 A good meeting ended in prayer.
