**Introduction to worship: Psalm 100**

**Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. For the Lord is good and His love endures for ever; His faithfulness continues through all generations.**

**We gratefully give thanks for all You have done Messiah, as well as all You are going to do in our lives. In Jesus' Holy Name. Amen.**

Thank You that because of the cross of Jesus we know that You love us and that Your Spirit reassures us of Your love in so many ways. Thank you that we have experienced in our church family Your rescuing work through the work of Your Holy Spirit in people's lives. We continue to pray that You would rescue us from the hardships we face in accordance with Your will. We thank You that we can pray for our Christian brothers and sisters to be delivered throughout the world, this we do now asking that You would hear our prayers and answer them. We pray this in the powerful name of Jesus. Amen.

Loving Jesus, You are compassionate to those in need and heal the sick in body and mind. Look kindly on those who are fearful at this time. Help us all to put away all thoughts and actions that separate us from You and from one another. Give us grace to live our lives confident in Your promise that You are with us always. Keep us, good Lord, under the shadow of Your wings of refuge. Sustain and support the anxious, be with those who care for the sick, and lift up all who are brought low, that we may find comfort knowing that nothing can separate us from Your love in Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen.
