Let the redeemed of the LORD tell their story—


those He redeemed from the hand of the foe

Reading and Talk – Matthew 8:5-13

⁵ When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. ⁶ 'Lord,' he said, 'my servant lies at home paralysed, suffering terribly.'

⁷ Jesus said to him, 'Shall I come and heal him?'

⁸ The centurion replied, 'Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. ⁹ For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, "Go," and he goes; and that one, "Come," and he comes. I say to my servant, "Do this," and he does it.'

When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, 'Truly I tell you, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith. ¹¹I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. ¹² But the subjects of the kingdom will be thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'







The Communion Prayer

With Your whole Church throughout the world we offer You this sacrifice of praise and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven:




